



Frequently Asked Questions

1. Disabled Seating

If you require disabled seating, please email ticket_office@lasvegasevents.com to request handicap seating for individual performances. There is limited availability for handicap seating, and may not be available for every performance.

2. When will I receive my season tickets

Season tickets are mailed out mid-October. If you do not receive your tickets by November 1st, please contact the Las Vegas Events ticket office immediately at 702-260-8605.

3. Do you accept credit cards as a form of payment

We can now accept credit cards as form of payment; however there is a 5% credit card fee that will be added to your total.

4. What is the \$20 Shipping and Handling Fee for

This fee covers the shipping and handling of Wrangler NFR tickets as well as the correspondence sent to all season ticket holders throughout the year.

5. Can I pick up my season tickets at the box office during the rodeo

You have the option of picking up season tickets at the Thomas and Mack Center Box Office. To do this, please email ticket_office@lasvegasevents.com prior to October 1st, to make Will-Call arrangements.

6. How do I sell my tickets to the Wrangler NFR Ticket Exchange

You may sell your tickets at the Wrangler NFR Ticket Exchange during the Wrangler NFR, or you have the option of mailing tickets to the ticket office before the Wrangler NFR. Please visit the Official Wrangler NFR Ticket Exchange for more instructions.

7. Address Change

If you need to make an address change, please find the Change of Address document under "Ticket Forms" on the home page. Fill out this document, and email to ticket_office@lasvegasevents.com. You will receive a confirmation via email or mail. This will guarantee that your invoices, tickets, and all correspondence will be mailed to the new address.

8. Transferring/Willing of Wrangler NFR Tickets

Season ticket holders may transfer or will their tickets to immediate family. Please visit the Wrangler NFR Ticket Policy for more information.

9. Seat Improvements

Season ticket holders may request seat improvements in their respective price levels. To request a seat improvement, please submit a written letter to the Las Vegas Events ticket office with your name, account number, and the location you would like to be moved to. Season ticket improvements are made upon the number of released seats each year. Due to the low amount of season ticket turnover, seat improvements cannot be guaranteed. 10. How do I find Individual Performance Tickets?

Each year, we have a limited number of individual performance tickets available to the general public. Tickets are based on availability and may not be available for every performance. 2010 Wrangler NFR Individual performance tickets will go on sale July 1st, 2010. To purchase tickets, please visit www.unlvtickets.com.

You may also purchase tickets at the Wrangler NFR Ticket Exchange at the Cowboy Christmas Gift Show, running concurrently with the Wrangler NFR. Please visit the Official Wrangler NFR Ticket Exchange on the home page for more information.

11. Waitlist

To join the waitlist, please fill out all information below. When season tickets become available, you will be contacted via mail or email. Please check to make sure all information is correct before signing up. If we do not hear from you when season tickets become available, we will assume you are no longer interested in purchasing. Season ticket availability is based on the amount of turnover in season ticket renewals; this will vary year to year.

12. Releasing NFR Season Tickets

If you choose to release your Wrangler NFR Season Tickets, you must submit a written letter via mail or email to the Las Vegas Events Ticket Office. Once you choose to release your season tickets, you will not have the ability to receive them in future years.

13. Invoicing/Payment Schedule

Invoices will be sent to all season ticket holders at the beginning of February, and will have a common due date of March 31. If we do not receive your payment
