FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Effective immediately, all contestants participating in the 2025 Junior National Finals Rodeo are strongly advised to present a complete and verifiable equine temperature log upon arrival at the event grounds.

Beginning **November 20, 2025**, and continuing throughout the entirety of the event (November 20-December 14, 2025), each horse must have **two documented temperature readings per day (AM & PM)**. All entries must be written clearly, dated accurately, and recorded by the responsible party.

Horses will be checked in daily on-site at the Las Vegas Convention Center. Upon arrival, please proceed directly to the designated parking lot and keep all horses inside the trailer until a veterinarian or staff member has reviewed your documentation.

Documentation

- Two temperature readings per horse per day (AM and PM) beginning November 20, 2025
- Each entry must include:
 - Date
 - Time of reading
 - Recorded temperature
 - o Initials of the individual who performed the reading
- Logs must be presented in printed form or via an approved digital format upon arrival
 - Any alterations, illegible entries, or missing data may be considered noncompliant
- All equine temperature logs will be inspected upon arrival at the Las Vegas Convention Center

Instructions for Compliance

- 1. Begin temperature monitoring on November 20, 2025.
- 2. Record temperatures twice daily, as close to 12 hours apart as practical.
- 3. Maintain the log in a secure and organized manner.
- 4. Present the completed log at the designated equine check-in location upon arrival
